She is not self-pitying, but makes it clear how difficult it was for everyone. Neither Jai nor Randy come off the scene as committed - they were very different people with different approaches to life - but their strong bond was evident throughout the book, even in stressful times, and it's easy to see why she misses him so much. Many of the beautiful parts of bringing Randy to life came close to the beginning. Jai notes that Randy, giving gifts is not about spending money but about putting hearts into it, and she later describes their weekend routine of making pancakes with a form of shape, allowing her children to decide what pancakes resembled. Probably half the book (perhaps a little more) covers her time with Randy, mostly after his diagnosis before his death, and then she covers her being trying to adjust to life without him. This build-up helped give a good overview of what her life as a caregiver entailed and how difficult it was, but how she is still not ready for his death. After he left, she no longer has the difficult task of caring for her husband along with her three young children, but it is even harder to take care of three children on her own without him, his absence looming over everyone. Her struggle to tell her children about Randy is particularly sad to read. Although she clearly has more resources than others in the same situation (paid house, nanny, family and friends, financial support), she doesn't know about it and even notes on the pages that she knows how not everyone is so lucky. Some of the strongest chapters were about her trying to set up right after died, wanting to bring back the magic that he had brought into her life, and that seemed to disappear with him. It was both an inspiring and heartbreaking read about her solo and family trips to the places they spoke to. She also detailed the possibilities that she captured after his death: cosmetic repairs, trading in a car she never liked, etc. - all trying to find hope where it didn't seem to be. While I wish there was a little more detail about her life without Randy and more details about her struggle (and the struggles of those around her) to adjust, it's such an encouraging and insightful book. Writing beautifully, the themes are handled gently but powerfully, and I believe it can give comfort to many people, just to know that they are not alone in their struggle.
